Nomination Guidelines

(One nomination per category per organisation)

Candidates must have been a member of a club, school or live in the Papatoetoe region in the qualifying period of 1 April 2018 to 31 August 2019.

Sportsman of the Year

To be nominated this individual would have shown an outstanding achievement(s) in their sport during the qualifying period.

Sportswoman of the Year

To be nominated this individual would have shown an outstanding achievement(s) in their sport during the qualifying period.

Team of the Year

To be nominated as Team of the Year this team would have demonstrated an outstanding achievement(s) in their sport during the qualifying period.

U18 Sportsman of the Year

To be nominated this individual would have shown an outstanding achievement(s) in their sport during the qualifying period. The candidate have been under 18 years of age on 1 Jan 2019.

U18 Sportswoman of the Year

To be nominated this individual would have shown an outstanding achievement(s) in their sport during the qualifying period. The candidate have been under 18 years of age on 1 Jan 2019.

U18 Team of the Year

To be nominated as Team of the Year this team would have demonstrated an outstanding achievement(s) in their sport during the qualifying period. The team needs to have competed in a U18 or lower completion in the qualifying period

International Recognition Award

To be nominated for International Recognition Award this individual would have represented a country at international level in their sport.

N.B. This category is not subject to judging.

Masters Sportsperson of the Year

To be nominated this individual would have shown an outstanding achievement(s) in their sport in a Masters competition during the qualifying period.

Administrator of the Year

To be nominated this individual should have been an outstanding administrator for your club throughout the qualifying period.





Coach of the Year

To be nominated this individual should have been an outstanding coach for your club throughout the qualifying period.

Outstanding Club Performer

To be nominated this individual should have been an outstanding participant relating to their club competition while representing the club in this competition. Provincial and/or National representatives are excluded from this category.

Services to Sport

To be nominated for their Service to Sport the individual would have shown outstanding service towards their club for many years. This may be as a player, coach, manager, committee member or administrator

N.B. This category is not subject to judging.

Information to Remember-IMPORTANT

- 1. Nominations must be precise to performance.
- 2. Nominations must relate to the qualifying period. 1 April 2018 to 31 August 2019.
- 3. The awards apply to Papatoetoe residents or members of Papatoetoe clubs, schools or organisation.
- 4. Nominations must be received by closing date: 5pm Friday 4 September.
- 5. Care need to be taken as to CATEGORY for which a person is nominated.
- 6. Adequate information with bullet points needs to be given on all relevant aspects –Judges decision are made on information provided.
- 7. One nomination per category per organisation.
